The International Conference on Informatics in Schools: Situation, Evolution, and Perspective (ISSEP) is an established forum for researchers and practitioners in the area of Computer Science Education with a focus on secondary schools. The 9th ISSEP conference will take place at the University of Münster, Germany. It will be held jointly with [WIPSCE 2016](#) (more details [here](#)). The conference language is English.

The organisers of ISSEP 2016 cordially invite you to submit a workshop proposal. Workshops are distinguished meeting points for getting informed about the ongoing work in our relevant fields and covering current topics preferably in practical informatics at all school levels.

Due to a very tight conference schedule, we offer “short workshops (about 45 minutes)”, providing participants with opportunities for exhibitions and discussions about special topics. In particular, workshop proposals which are not covered by talks (see list of accepted papers on the ISSEP webpage) and also from an interdisciplinary standpoint (e.g. languages, mathematics, physics, sport...) are welcome.

We encourage the submission of workshop proposals on (but not restricted to):

- Creativity engines to learn informatics principle and programming languages (Simulations, Fractals, ...), development environments and programming interfaces
- Maker movement (e.g. robotics)
- CS unplugged activities and informatics contests/challenges
- Web applications, web collaboration and production tools (e.g. MOOCS and e-books)
- Good practice and worked out examples
- Short and long term lesson plans, reference models and special curricular issues

In case of overlapping workshops themes are proposed, the committee may contact the organisers to discuss the possibility of merging workshops. Please note that the duration of a workshop might need to be adjusted based on the overall number of submissions received. Furthermore, workshops where less than five people registered might be cancelled.

Authors are invited to submit the workshop proposals to [issep2016@easychair.org](mailto:issep2016@easychair.org)

The submission shall contain an abstract of the workshop, short biographies of the workshop leaders, a description of the materials provided, and a tentative agenda for the workshop. The submission should not exceed two pages. Abstracts of accepted workshops will be published in the ISSEP 2016 proceedings.
